Please note that there is an error on page 1 of "Various Small Objects and Fragments from Anibeh", enclosed in my letter of Oct. 13th last. The small ivory cone (Photo. 2914, c), given under (C) as from An. 14, (b), Not Catalogued, really comes from An. 19, and not from An. 14 (see Field Notes of An. 19). The number written on the object looks more like "14" than "19".
