"I was sorry to learn that he had been  
unable to find any method of financing  
its publication. The University of Chicago  
Press is facing a difficult financial situa-  
tion at present. .... and it does not  
surprise me much that the Press is  
unwilling to undertake this publi-  
cation without an outside subsidy.  
Wick believes that the publication of  
the large grammar will hurt the sale  
of a smaller one, even though I did  
my best to attempt to persuade him  
that the two books would really  
supplement each other rather than  
compete with each other."
