Dear Uncle George:

I have just had a talk with Miss Vaun Gillmor of the Bollingen Foundation about the parts of the large Grammar for which estimates have not been made. She says that the Foundation would like to have at least an approximate idea of the cost of these parts. These parts would include, I assume, the following:

At the front of the book, the foreword, a detailed table of contents and a list of abreviations.

At the back of the book, a bibliography, which, I gather from your last letter, would only cover two or three pages, since you would refer the student to the bibliography of Mallon or some other full bibliography.

Then there would be the separate reading exercises and vocabulary for which an approximate estimate is also desired. I know you are concentrating now on the correction of galley proof, but I thought you might be able to give Augustin an approximate idea of the number of printed pages which would be necessary for these additional parts in terms of the second edition of the Grammar. Augustin could then submit an approximate figure of costs to the University of Chicago Press. I do not recall whether you plan to use different texts for the reading exercises from those which appear in the second edition of the large Grammar. I have just talked to a Mr. Coughlin of Augustin's office. He says that Mr. Augustin is at present in Arizona where his address is, General Delivery, Winslow, Arizona. Mr. Coughlin suggests that you might write directly to Mr. Augustin at Winslow. I have told Mr. Coughlin that he can come to this Department at any time and see a copy of the second edition of the large Grammar.

I don't think we have ever discussed the format of the Grammar. I suppose that you have probably come to some decision about this. I simply would like to say that I hope you may have decided on a somewhat larger size of page than was used for the second edition. However, that is a matter entirely for your own decision.
