The last entry (E. 11371) in
Woolley's Anibeh Catalogue is

"Large sandstone slab (broken into
a number of pieces) found on the site of
the temple of Rameses II on the W.
bank opposite the N. bluff of Kasr
Ibrim."

I enclose a photo of the stone,
taken on the field. It was evidently
broken in transportation, and a small
part of ^{it} cannot be found. I should be
glad to know if you would like to publish
this inscription with the Anibeh mater-
ial. If so, I will send you a careful
copy.
