Dear Professor Steindorff,

Many thanks for your letter of the 5th Oct. I am delighted to know that up to now your work has not been delayed for lack of the Anibeh material ~~from~~ here. I am again busy with this, and hope to send you what you require at frequent intervals. Yesterday I sent you eleven photographs of the scarabs. The Museum numbers are on the back of the prints. The dimensions, numbers of the tombs from which ~~that~~<sup>they</sup> came, and other details (including the materials) are entered in a catalogue drawn up by Woolley years ago; unfortunately I have to keep this here until nearly the end, as I could not control the material without it. There are a few more scarabs to come, and after that I shall, I think, send you the amulets. I am at present again working on the shawabtis.
