Dear Steindorff

I sent the second lot of workmen at your request. The warrants for the transport of bread will be sent to Sadiq tomorrow.

The boxes of pottery should I think be sent in one consignment unless they are in your way. Mark them in some way so that they are not likely to be confused with those of Emery.

I am sending you blank warrants for the return of the workmen, the cost & their luggage by steamer and rail. The cost's warrant is made out to Cairo.

I will also send <sup>blank</sup> warrants for the transport of the pottery boxes <sup>to Shellal</sup>. We have a special rate for the transport of Antiquities and we can send your boxes in a special truck from Shellal to the Museum Yard.

The boxes can go from Aniba to Shellal either on the Gort steamer or by the 'Delta' (but send a man or two with the boxes.) Number the boxes and keep a note as to the contents of each box: The Delta steamer does not accept our warrants so it would be better to use the Gort steamer. For your own return we can doubtless arrange for the <sup>Express</sup> Gort steamer to stop & pick you up, but I should have good notice so as to arrange with the Sudan office in Cairo.
