Dear Dr. Steinhardt

I was very much interested to see reproduced in a London weekly paper certain photographs of the excavations which you directed at Amada in Upper Egypt and in particular by the photograph of a clay figurine. In the course of my travels with my brother in 1927 in the southern Sahara, in Aïr, I discovered and recorded a number of petroglyphs which so confuse any conclusions which their absence might have allowed one to draw from recorded history that I cannot for the moment attempt to place or to date them. I find however that one group of these glyphs in northern Aïr bear such a very striking resemblance both in anatomical conception and style of incised

decoration to the figures reproduced, that I am taking the liberty of asking you if you will allow me to examine any other photographs you may possess of other figures and in their absence any sketches you may have made.

The points which I would most like to ascertain are (1) whether there are any holes in the head of the figures into which plumes, grass or any other head dress might have been inserted.

(2) whether any of them show traces of plaits or locks laterally on the side of the head or on top.

(3) whether any indication of a mouth appears in the faces of any of them.

(4) whether any of them have
frans or indications of sexual organs.

(5) whether any of them have any
different or more elaborate incised decoration
on the torso and if so what.

disposal and shall do so as soon as I return
to London where they are. Meanwhile I
have drawn from memory some characteristic
drawings of the class to which I refer
for your guidance.
