#### Student Outcomes

Students will be expected to

- Engage in the seminar activity.
- Interact with the speaker (e.g. asking questions during or after the presentation).
- Summarize the subject material at a broad level.

Seminars are important to graduate student development because they bring the frontier to SMU. This is how all scientists engage in the latest findings, debate the conclusions of those findings, and develop relationships with new researchers that can enrich the scientist's own work.

## Participation

This is the primary means of assessing engagement in this material, since each seminar in unique. Participation is achieved either by:

- Reviewing a recording of the seminar/colloquium after-the-fact and reporting on this activity to the instructor.

- Students who participate in all but two of the speaker series events earn a B in the course.
- Students who participate in all but three of the speaker series events earn a C in the course.
