IMPORTANT DATES

- August 25** - Opening Convocation 5:00 p.m.

(NEW first-year and transfer students only)
- August 26** - First day of classes
- August 30** - LAST DAY to enroll, ADD courses, or DROP courses without tuition billing while remaining enrolled for the term
- September 2** - Labor Day Holiday
- September 9** - Last day to drop a course without academic record (**tuition charges apply**)
- September 11** - Last day to declare no-credit grading option for a course
- October 2** - Early Intervention Deficiency Reports available to undergraduate students
- October 7-8** - Fall Break
- October 29** - Mid-Term Deficiency Reports available to undergraduate students
- Mid-November** - Deadline to order regalia for December Commencement
- November 26** - Last day to: declare a course pass/fail; drop a course; and withdraw from the University
- December 9** - Last day of classes
- December 10-11** - Reading Days
- December 12-18** - Final Examinations (Grades due 72 hours after final exam)
- December 20** - December Rotunda Recessional

ENROLLMENT & BURSAR (PAYMENT) INFORMATION

You should NOT attend a class in which you are not officially enrolled! Classes begin on Monday, August 26. If you have not enrolled, you have through **Friday, August 30**. Payment is due at the time of enrollment. Select link for information on how to pay. smu.edu/bursar/webpay.asp

The last day to ADD courses or DROP courses without tuition billing (while remaining enrolled for the term) is Friday, August 30 until 11:59 p.m. The last day to DROP a course without academic record ([tuition charges apply](#)) is Monday, September 9. Remember that it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to ensure that your enrollment is accurate and all University deadlines are met.

“NO CREDIT” OR “PASS/FAIL” OPTION

Students may take some undergraduate courses for “No Credit” or “Pass/Fail.” **“No Credit” Option** - Students should indicate in writing no later than the 12th class day that they wish to do so. Permission of the instructor or department is required. **“Pass/Fail” Option** - 12 hours of pass/fail hours are the maximum total credits that a student can use towards a degree assuming a passing grade in the class. Grades of C- or higher are considered passing. Deadline to complete the Pass/Fail Option Declaration form is indicated in the [academic calendar](#). Forms are available online [here](#). PERSONAL INFORMATION VERIFICATION

Students are required to verify their personal information twice a year. Failure to do so will result in a HOLD being placed which prohibits future enrollment. Students should update their personal information as the need arises. Click on My Profile and then Contact Info on the left-hand side in my.SMU. Update address, phone, and/or emergency contacts whenever necessary.

EXCUSED ABSENCES

Students who participate in officially sanctioned scheduled extracurricular activities or observe a religious holiday should be given an opportunity to make up class examinations or other graded assignments missed as a result of this activity. Students should be informed by the instructor at the beginning of the term, preferably in writing, of the instructor’s makeup policy.
