IMPORTANT DATES

August 22 - Opening Convocation 5:30 pm

August 23 - First day of classes

August 27 - LAST DAY to enroll, ADD courses, or DROP courses without tuition billing while remaining enrolled for the term

September 3 - Last day to drop a course without academic record (<u>tuition charges</u> apply)

September 6 - Labor Day Holiday

September 8 - Last day to declare pass/fail/ no credit

September 29 - Early Intervention Deficiency Reports available to undergraduate students

October 11-12 - Fall Break

October 25 - Mid-Term Deficiency Reports available to undergraduate students

November 5 - Last day to drop course with a W

November 22 - Deadline to order regalia for December Commencement

ENROLLMENT & BURSAR (PAYMENT) INFORMATION

You should NOT attend a class in which you are not officially enrolled! Classes begin on Monday, August 23. If you have not enrolled, you have through Friday, August 27. Payment is due at the time of enrollment. Select link for information on how to pay. smu.edu/bursar/webpay.asp

The last day to ADD courses or DROP courses without tuition billing (while remaining enrolled for the term) is Friday, August 27 until 11:59 p.m. The last day to DROP a course without academic record (tuition charges apply) is Friday, September 3. Remember that it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to ensure that your enrollment is accurate and all University deadlines are met.

"NO CREDIT" OR "PASS/FAIL" OPTION

Students may take some undergraduate courses for "No Credit" or "Pass/Fail." "No Credit" Option - Students should indicate in writing no later than the 12th class day that they wish to do so. Permission of the instructor or department is required. "Pass/Fail" Option – 12 hours of pass/fail hours are the maximum total credits that a student can use towards a degree assuming a passing grade in the class. Grades of C- or higher are considered passing. Deadline to complete the Pass/Fail Option Declaration form is the 12th class day. Forms are available in the Office of the Academic Dean. PERSONAL INFORMATION VERIFICATION

Students are required to verify their personal information twice a year. Failure to do so will result in a HOLD being placed which prohibits future enrollment. Students should update their personal information as the need arises. Click on My Profile and then Contact Info on the left-hand side in my.SMU. Update address, phone, and/or emergency contacts whenever necessary.

EXCUSED ABSENCES

Students who participate in officially sanctioned scheduled extracurricular activities or observe a religious holiday should be given an opportunity to make up class examinations or other graded assignments missed as a result of this activity. Students should be informed by the instructor at the beginning of the term, preferably in writing, of the instructor's makeup policy.
